- -Any full-length work of fiction
- (novel or collection of short stories)
- -Published Jan. 1, 2024 through Dec. 31, 2024
- Galleys for a 2024 publication are also accepted
- -The writer must be an African-American U.S. citizen
- -Self-published books will not be accepted
- -Emailed entries will not be accepted
